City Hall Council Chambers:

ROLL CALL:

The City Council of Lincoln Center convened in special session at 6:30 p.m. with Mayor Travis Schwerdtfager presiding. Councilmembers present: Elijah Keever, Melodee Larsen, Angela K. Corpstein, Hayden Howard, and Mark Luce. Officials present: Attorney Jeffrey A. Norris and City Clerk Heather N. Hillegeist. Also present: Superintendent Jeff Ahring.

VISITORS:

Others in attendance for all or portions of the meeting: Kelly Gourley.

BASE GRANT BIDS:

Kelly Gourley conveyed that the Lincoln County Economic Development Foundation (LCEDF) had advertised for bids for a general, plumbing, heating, and HVAC contractors for the renovation of the downtown building located at 127 W. Lincoln Avenue. The LCEDF board reviewed the bids and had recommendations for the Governing Body for selection of contractors. Corpstein moved to approve Justin Huiett for the general contractor in the amount of \$72,329. Motion seconded by Larsen, carried.

Following discussion, Keever moved to deny the recommendation from the LCEDF board of Double H for electrical, plumbing and HVAC due to conflict of interest, seconded by Luce. Carried. Howard abstained. Gourley would relay the decision of the governing body to the LCEDF board.

There being no further business, Corpstein moved to adjourn. Motion seconded by Larsen, carried. Council adjourned at 5:53 p.m.
