ORDINANCE NO. 722

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SUNDAY SALES OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR AND CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE IN THE ORIGINAL PACKAGE WITHIN THE CITY OF LINCOLN CENTER, KANSAS.

Be it Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Lincoln Center, Kansas:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 41-2704 and K.S.A. 41-2911, the sale at retail of cereal malt beverage in the original package is allowed within the City on any Sunday, except Easter, between the hours of 12:00 noon and 8:00 p.m.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 41-712 and K.S.A. 41-2911, the sale at retail of alcoholic liquor in the original package is allowed within the City on any Sunday, except Easter, between the hours of 12:00 noon and 8:00 p.m., and on Memorial Day, Independence Day and Labor Day.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect 61 days after final publication, unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed, requiring a referendum to be held on the Ordinance as provided in K.S.A. 41-2911, in which case this Ordinance shall become effective upon approval by a majority of the electors voting thereon.
