

LINCOLN CEMETERY REGULATIONS

The following regulations are adopted for the Lincoln City Cemetery this 12th day of March, 2001:

1. All flowers (cut or artificial) must be displayed in containers. Flowers in permanent vases (attached to or constructed as part of the stone or stone base) may remain year round. Flowers in glass, plastic or metal containers may be displayed only over Memorial Day or on special occasions such as holidays, birthdays, anniversaries or funerals (for example).
2. All flowers other than those in permanent vases must be removed within two weeks after Memorial Day or after the special occasion. All flowers and containers remaining at the cemetery may be removed and disposed of by city employees after the two-week period.
3. Any winter or special occasion decorations shall be picked up within two weeks after display and in any event before April 1.
4. No permanent trees or shrubs shall be planted anywhere around the graves. Planting of permanent flowers is discouraged but is permitted at the north or south end of the monument with nothing to be planted in front or behind the monument or marker.
5. Decorative rock shall not be permitted in the cemetery.
6. Permanent vases shall be placed at the north or south end of the monument with nothing in front or behind the monument or marker except veteran medallions.
7. Spraying by the City for dandelions and weed control will be done in the fall for maintenance and beautification. The City will spray the ground around monuments and markers.

These regulations shall become effective as of March 15, 2001.
